Minutes of the April 3, 2024 meeting were approved as distributed, with correction...added to minutes others in attendance: Mayor Stephen Paduhovich, Treasurer Marian Hunter, and Secretary Mindy Barshinger.

Payment of bills: Motion by Don Barshinger, seconded by Victor Dodson, to approve and pay the general account bills and accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Patrons – Kurvin & Kathy Schrum, Karen Royer, Emily Fuhrman, Tina Pauhovich (all only to observe), Matt Fauth & Laura Barshinger-EPFC-asked about fireworks on Memorial Day week-end....said he would start asking for help...also mentioned that the fire company is holding a chicken BBQ on Saturday of Memorial Day week-end....

Chief Thomas (LWTPD) passed out April 2024 incident report...mentioned that scrapping people are taking things out of back yards...Chief said that residents will be notified not to put anything in their driveways that they don't want to be picked up......Question was asked if electric pedi-cycles are allowed on the road – Chief said that this is still in legislation.

Old Business – Beautification project – Victor is going to check on prices for a 20-foot flagpole and solar powered light for the flag....he also is going to contact Auto Graphics to get a price on a double-sided sign...the sign we are looking at is vinyl with aluminum backing, with blue & yellow lettering...the price for a one-sided sign is \$ 360.40......Council must also decide where to place the sign and flagpole.

Solar speed signs – (1) of the signs is up and working....Mick has to put the other sign together....

Sound soak – (4) contacts were made for prices...(1) phone call to Lowe's, which was not returned...another phone call was made to Armstrong, which was not returned...a quote of \$ 19,973.00 was received from Dyndes, Inc....a quote was also received from Smucker's to place 26 panels (half of the walls), using tectum, for \$ 17,000.00.....Kim Godfrey made a motion, seconded by George Dvorak, to award the project to Smuckers...Motion carried.....a few minutes later, the motion was revised to include using all remaining money from the ARP account, which is \$ 19,256.14. Kim made the revised motion, seconded by George Dvorak...Motion carried.

Don will contact Smuckers and ask them to use all \$ 19,256.14....

Zoning officer: Invoices are being received each month....

Mayor's Report: Steve reported that he received a complaint about a dirt bike, running on Christine Drive, creating a nuisance for a neighbor....Don spoke to the complainant and the responsible party...said problem is taken care of....dirt bike is going to the mountains.

<u>Parks & Recreation Committee –</u> Don wants to see new mulch put around all the trees, at the playground/ball field, before Memorial Day.....He will ask for volunteers to help.....Kim Godfrey volunteered to use a homeopathic solution to treat the weeds in the mulch.
