Elections for Borough Offices

Several borough offices are on the ballot this year including 3 seats on the council and the constable that are up for four-year terms and a special election for tax collector that is up for a two-year term. We encourage our residents to participate in the process and in local government. Petitions to get on the ballot can be circulated starting February 19th and must be turned in to the York County Board of Elections by March 12th. It only takes ten signatures minimum from borough residents registered with your political party to file to run for office. Primary election day is Tuesday, May 21st and general election day is Tuesday, November 5th.
