MISCELLANEOUS NEWS :

- Keeping your property secure is a simple thing to do. Keeping porch or exterior lights on at night is a good deterrent. Inexpensive doorbell cameras can be purchased at stores like Lowes or Home Depot and can be registered at <https://york.crimewatchpa.com/lowerwindsortwppd/42207/webforms/camera-registry> Registering a camera assists police in solving a crime committed in your neighborhood.
- Borough street sweeping will take place in April and May. State roads, Main St. & Maple St., will be swept in April with the remainder of borough roads to be swept in May.
- Curb and crosswalk painting will be completed by the street committee within the next few months.
- The borough has received grants to extend sidewalks on South Main St. and West Maple St. These will likely be completed later this year.
- Borough residents are encouraged to express their point of view regarding the potential landfill expansion to the Lower Windsor Township board of supervisors.
- A borough ordinance currently prohibits installation of mailboxes on sidewalks. Residents will be notified of any changes.
