IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- As cooler weather approaches, please make sure your yard is not attractive to rodents/small animals looking for a winter home. Brush and excessive yard waste must be removed.
- While we aren't there yet, snow will likely return in the coming months. Residents must remove snow from sidewalks within 18 hours after the end of the snowstorm.
- When we have a plowable snow, please remove your car to a driveway or other parking area if able to help out our plow drivers.
- If you have an emergency, please call 911, not the borough office.
- Complaint forms, to report ordinance violations, are available outside the borough office at 28 W. Maple St. or online at epboro.com. **Form must be submitted to the borough in order for complaint to be acknowledged.**

MISCELLANEOUS NEWS :

- Renovations were recently made to the playground and basketball court in the form of new mulch at the playground and stones around the bleachers at the basketball court. Both the mulch and stones are meant only to be walked on. This work was completed at considerable expense. If you or your children use either area, please remind them to leave the mulch and stones on the ground.
- Some much needed renovations will be forthcoming to the borough office and community hall in order to serve our neighbors better.
- New residential development plans are in the works for two areas in the borough: one at the edge of town on West Maple St. and the other near the ambulance club. Details on either development will be shared as information becomes available.
- The sidewalk extensions originally planned for this year have been delayed until next year.
- Curb painting has been completed. This is done every 3 years.
- Keeping your property secure is a simple thing to do. Keeping porch or exterior lights on at night is a good deterrent. Inexpensive doorbell cameras can be purchased at stores like Lowes or Home Depot and can be registered at <https://york.crimewatchpa.com/lowerwindsortwppd/42207/webforms/camera-registry> Registering a camera assists police in solving a crime committed in your neighborhood.
