ORDINANCE NO. 2000 - 3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2000-2 BY  
ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF  
PARKING LIMITATIONS ON CERTAIN STREETS OF THE  
BOROUGH OF EAST PROSPECT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the  
Borough of East Prospect, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 2000-2 shall be amended by the addition  
of the following Section:

Section 5. Any person who violates any  
provision of this Ordinance shall, upon  
conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not  
more than \$600 and costs, provided that it  
shall be the duty of the police officers to  
report to the appropriate official all  
violations of any provision of the Ordinance,  
indicating in each case the section violated;  
the license number of the vehicle involved in  
the violation, the location where the  
violation took place and any other facts that  
might be necessary in order to secure a clear  
understanding of the circumstances attending  
the violation. The police officer or the  
other person making the report shall also  
attach to or place upon every such vehicle a  
notice stating that the vehicle was parked in  
violation of this Ordinance. The notice shall  
contain instructions to the owner or driver of  
the vehicle that, if he will pay the sum of  
\$600 within five days of the date of the  
notice, that act will save the violator from  
prosecution and from payment of the fine and  
costs prescribed in the first sentence of this  
section.


Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are  
inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective  
immediately upon enactment.
